

## Healthcare Leadership Course Coach Qualifications & Responsibilities



### Coaching Qualifications

- Current or recently retired healthcare leader
- Ability to provide “one on one” time with each participant over a 15 week period (approximately 1.5 hours per week)
- Able to complete a short Coach Orientation program
- Enjoys teaching and mentoring others

### Coaching Leadership Skills – a “coach” has the ability to:

- Effectively communicate and interact on an interpersonal level
- Skillfully lead groups of people
- Act as a role model
- Role play managerial scenarios
- Provide critiques/feedback to the participant and maintain written documentation
- Motivate others to excel in whatever they do
- Have fun and enjoy the work, the role, and the participant
