Driving Directions to Fairview Hospital - 18101 Lorain Avenue

From the West or East via I-90

Exit at McKinley Avenue

Turn left (from west-bound exit) or right (from east-bound exit). Proceed south on McKinley to Rocky River Drive (Rt. 237)

Turn left on Rocky River Drive and proceed to Lorain Avenue (Kamm's Corners Shopping Plaza and the Shell station will be on the right)

Turn right onto Lorain Avenue. Stay in the left lane and proceed straight into the hospital campus as Lorain bears to the right.

Parking garage is on your left

From I-71 or East via I-480

Exit at West 150th Street and proceed north

Proceed on West 150th to Lorain Avenue (K-Mart will be on the right corner)

Turn left on Lorain Avenue and pass Kamm's Corners Shopping Plaza. Stay in the left lane and proceed straight into the hospital campus as Lorain bears to the right

Parking garage is on your left

From the West via I-480

Exit at Grayton Road

Turn left on Grayton Road and proceed north to Puritas Avenue

Turn right on Puritas and proceed to Rocky River Drive (Rt. 237)

Turn left on Rocky River and proceed to Lorain Avenue

Turn left on Lorain. Stay in the left lane and proceed straight into the hospital campus as Lorain bears to the right

Parking garage is on your left

Fairview Hospital Student Shadowing Program Guidelines

Fairview Hospital is pleased to offer a career shadowing experience to high school students interested in a future career in healthcare. This career shadowing experience provides the student the privilege of spending time with a healthcare professional in their area of interest and experiencing what a real day on the job is like. This is an excellent opportunity for students to ask questions and obtain information about their career choice. Students interested in a shadowing experience at Fairview Hospital are expected to read the Student Shadowing Program Guidelines.

Program Requirements

- At Fairview Hospital we put our Patient's First and value their privacy. Students selected for a shadowing experience will be required to read and sign a confidentiality agreement. Privacy violations will not be tolerated and you will be dismissed from the premises.
- The minimum age requirement for shadowing is 16.
- Professional conduct is expected. You are a guest in the hospital. Display active listening skills and a positive attitude. Please arrive on time and be respectful and courteous to hospital personnel and patients.
- You will be changing into hospital scrubs each day you are here. Wear clean tennis shoes or other comfortable closed toe shoes with socks or appropriate hosiery. No extreme hairstyles, makeup or jewelry and no perfume.
- Please limit the items you bring with you to what you can fit in your pocket. Purses and backpacks should be left at home. Fairview Hospital is not responsible for lost personal items. Cell phones must be turned off. No other electronic devices of any kind are permitted. No photography of any kind is permitted.
- Smoking is not permitted at any Cleveland Clinic facility.
- No one is permitted in clinical areas without an ID badge.

On the day of your shadowing experience

- Park in the hospital parking garage. There is a fee for parking.
- Be sure to bring completed paperwork including confidentiality statement and authorization forms with you. You will not be permitted to shadow without completed forms.
- You will meet Marla Daugherty in the Main Lobby near the fish tank. From here, you will obtain your scrubs, process your signed forms in the Volunteer Office, and receive your ID badge. You must have your driver's license or picture ID with you in order to obtain an ID badge.
- Lunch is not provided by the hospital – there is a cafeteria if you would like to purchase food & beverage.
